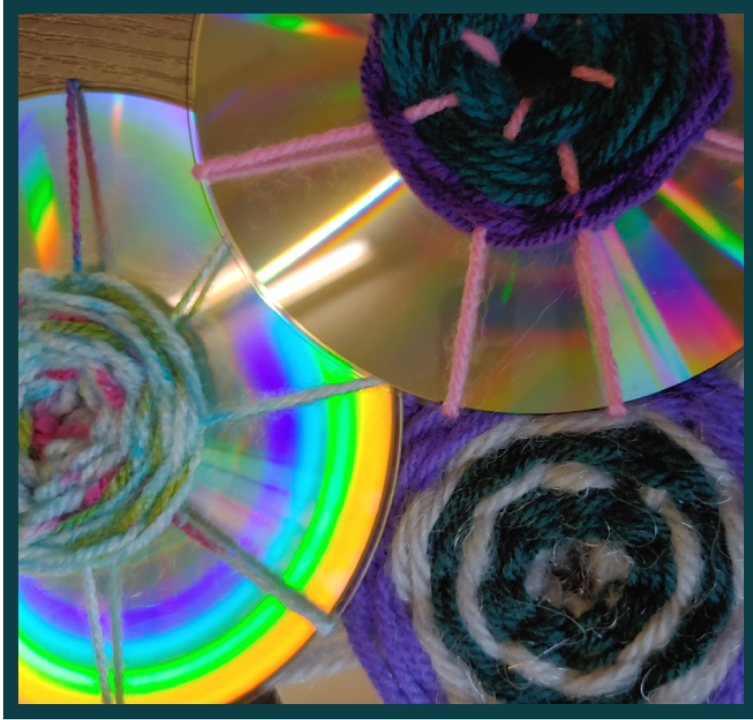


CD Weaving

SIR RICHARD ARKWRIGHT'S
**CROMFORD
MILLS**



You will need:

- An old CD
- Coloured yarn/wool
- Scissors

Method

- Cut a long length of wool. Poke it through the middle of the CD and wind it round the edge an **odd number of times**. This creates your 'warp'. It should look like spokes on a wheel. Tie the wool so it is secure.
- Choose another colour: this is your 'weft'. Tie it to the warp on the shiny side of the CD and start weaving: over, then under, then over, and so on.

Tips

- Change colour whenever you want!
- Add in beads as you weave to add texture
- Tie a long loop to the CD when you have finished, so you can hang it up in a window or outside, so it catches the light and sparkles!
